A regular meeting of the Bald Eagle Repeater Association was held on Monday evening January 16, 1984 at the home of John Cooper, WB3JFV in Montoursville.

the meeting was called to order by the President, Melvin Bennett, KC3EH at 7:39 pm. Members present were John Cooper, WB3JFV, Bob Shearer, N3AFX, John Dover, WB3DKC, Mick McBride, W3ILG, Kurt Hunter, WB3AGC, Ken Frey, WB3HOI, Herb Raemsch, WA3HGT, Guests present were Bill Hitchens, KC3EC and Jason McBride.

The Minutes of the meetins April 19, 1983 and June 6, 1983 were read by the secretary Ken Frey and were approved.

The Treasurer report was given by the Club Treasurer, John Cooper and reported: access left in Treasurer and carried over from the year 1983, \$158.49. John reported that 20 members had paid their 1984 dues to date. The New Balance in the Treasury is \$469.49. John reported all bills were paid up to date. The monthly phone bill is now \$29.36 a month and \$10.00 rental for the VHI building that houses the repeater. The Treasurer report was approved as read.

John Cooper made a motion to pay Bob Shearer dues with the VHF group of \$20.00 yearly dues. This was approved.



First prize \$50.00, Second prize \$25.00, Third prize \$10.00, Fourth and Fifth and sixth \$5.00 each for a total of \$100.00 to be given away. The drawing would be held on April 2nd 1984. Ken Frey said he would have the tickets printed up as soon as possible. Another meeting was called for January 31st at 7:00 at John Coopers to get the Ticket raffle started. This ended all regular business and the meeting was adjourned at 9:48 pm.
