

# Bald Eagle Repeater Association

A meeting of the Bald Eagle Repeater Association was held on April 17, 1986 at the home of Bob Shearer located in Rd Montoursville. The Meeting was called to Order at 8:00 P.M. by the President, Melvin Bennett. The Minutes of the last Meeting were read by the Secretary, Ken Frey and were Approved as read.

The Treasurer report was given by the Treasurer, Herb Baensch and reported:  
Old Balance - ~~\$658.48~~ <sup>\$658.48</sup> Bills Paid to date were: Bell of Penna phone bill \$204.68, \$27.96 A.T.T., \$120.00 Rent, \$20.00 Bob Shearer's dues for the JHF Society. Total Paid Dots were \$372.64 fees taken in \$503.00 to date.  
New Balance in Treasury \$758.48. On a motion by Hank Palmaier to accept the Secretary & Treasury reports was seconded by Paul Burnham and they were accepted.

Bob Shearer reported on the repeater and the antenna. The antenna

John Good was satisfied of the problem and stated that the problem was taken care of the best he could do. It was reported that Paul Birmingham, N2DXL was now taking care of the CAP repeater and that if any further problems come up to notify him.

The Emergency Back up was discussed in detail and there is still a need of <sup>proper</sup> Grotek battery to regulate the voltage. Bob stated that if a battery is secured that the Emergency Batteries should be operational in the next couple of months.

A motion was made by John Hover to pay \$100.00 to Marshall Webley in payment of the repeaters and \$100.00 to Bob Shearer in payment of the repeater was seconded by Joyce Hover. The motion was approved and payment made. Note: A balance of \$100.00 is still outstanding to Marshall Webley on the repeaters and \$200.00 outstanding to Bob Shearer for payment of the repeater.
