Page ① Minutes of Meeting, June 12, 1997.

A Meeting of the Bald Eagle Repeater Association was held on Thursday Evening June 12, 1997 at the home of Bob & Peg Sheerer R.R. Montoursville, Pa.

The Meeting was called to order by the President, John Rymell, N3 PFF at 7:05 P.M.

The Minutes of the Meeting held on April 23, 1997, were read by the Secretary.

Ken Ray, WB3Hoi. On a motion by Bill Barnes to accept the Minutes as read was seconded by Bob Sheerer and they were approved.

The Treasurer report was given by the Club Treasurer Peg Sheerer and reported: Old Balance of \$828.87. Money paid out to P & L \$13.42, \$14.69 Beef Atlantic, \$3.00 for Bank Service Charge. The New balance is \$797.76. \$10.00 was received from John Rymell for the use of Auto patch on toll calls. This clearing a New balance of \$807.76. on a motion by Ryan Gross to accept the Treasurer report was seconded by Jack Shaffer and the Treasurer report was accepted as read.

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Under old Business Bob reported on the Antennae problem for the repeater. Bob stated a new Station Master Antenna would cost \$569.25 plus \$65.00 shipping charges. Bob stated that he had a Shakespeare Antennae to replace the existing Antennae at the tower site, and that he would like to try this Antennae before investing in a new one. Bob stated that he would prefer to send the old Station Master Antennae back for repairs which would cost \$65.00 for shipping plus repairs. A work day was scheduled for June 21st. Saturday at 9:00 a.m. at the tower site to replace the Antennae and spruce up the lot.

John <sup>Rymell</sup> reported on the VE Testing and stated that he had no. had a chance to secure a Chair person and that possibly would have something more definite in the fall.

Under New Business John Rymell suggested that the Club Members help sites Club groups with Hamfests, VE Testing or whatever would be needed on a volunteer basis.

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This will be discussed further at the next meeting to be held Sept. 18, 1947 to get a more general consensus of the group. John also mentioned the idea of offering New Hams in the area to join the Club at reduced rate of \$10.00. This idea was generally agreed and would be discussed further before being put to the floor for a motion.

This ended all regular Club business and on a motion by Bill Barnes to adjourn was seconded by Keith Brown and the meeting was adjourned at 7:33 P.M.
